

Studio Sales Pottery, Gallery and Pottery Supply store:

The Pottery Gallery and Pottery Supply business are both located at the restored Schoolhouse at 5569 East Avon Road. Hours are posted on the website. As per NYS:

- **Customers and staff required to wear masks at all times. If you aren't wearing a mask or refuse to do so, you will be asked to leave.**
- Maintain 6 feet social distancing.
- Hand sanitizer is available at the door and washing hands is available in the gallery and restroom area.
- Stay home if you are feeling sick.

Studio Sales Pottery, Open Studio Participation:

The Pottery Community Studio is located at the 5557 East Avon Road. Studio usage is available by sign up for classes, renting studio space or renting studio time. As per NYS:

- All staff, faculty, and students must wash their hands immediately after entering the building. The studio has soap dispensers at the sink and in the bathroom at the sink.
- **All staff, faculty, and students are required to wear masks at all times. If you aren't wearing a mask or refuse to do so, you will be asked to leave.**
- Stay home if you are feeling sick.
- The open studio format to a maximum of 3 people for the wheels and one person for glazing at a time.
- Maintain 6 feet social distancing.
- Studio usage has to be reserved on the Google sheet.
- Limit one person at the sink or wedging tables at one time.
- I would also suggest gloves to be used when glazing but that is not required that I can find.
- No food will be allowed in the studio. Sealed beverage containers labeled with your name on it are permitted.
- No children or additional guests will be allowed in the studio when the occupancy is at 3; a quick visit to show work or progress is fine when occupancy allows.
- Do not change the arrangement of the wheels and tables.
- Open studio participants will be responsible for their own tools, plastic for covering pieces in progress and buckets, preferably covered containers.
- Shelves are available for storage of work. Tools and buckets should be taken out and brought in, not left onsite.
- Recycle by Studio Sales is not an option at this time – scrap clay and slop is the participant's responsibility.
- Follow appropriate respiratory hygiene and cough etiquette.

When you arrive there will be a couple of screening questions. When leave your work area(s) should be cleaned and disinfected with materials I will provide. I will also follow that up with disinfecting between space usages.

If studio participants or anyone in their household is suspected of having COVID-19, or has tested positive for COVID-19, they should notify Studio Sales immediately after the call to your local health department. Your privacy will be respected; however, I will take the necessary action of to communicate any potential spread of the virus including closing for a short time so I can disinfect the studio.
